1a. What is your name?

My name is _____

E.g. I live in Bucheon city, near Bucheon College.

2a. How many brothers and sisters do you have? (1)

I have _____ brothers/sisters in my family.

E.g. I have 1 sister in my family. I have no brothers.

2b. Do you enjoy spending time with your family? (1) c.

Why? (3)

i. Yes I do. I really enjoy spending time with them because they are **(adjective 1) and (adjective 2)**. Also I like **(name of activity) and (name of activity)** with them.

E.g. Yes I do. I really enjoy spending time with them because they are very kind and fun to be with. Also I like to watch movies with them and eat dinner with them on the weekends.

Sentence 1

Describe Time + **I was** + **[describe activity you were doing]** + **[with whom?]**

E.g. Yesterday I was biking to school by myself.

Sentence 2 + 3

[Describe WHAT happened or what you did]

E.g. Suddenly, a car appeared from the side street. The car didn't see me and it hit me on the side! Luckily, however, I wasn't seriously injured.

Sentence 4+5

[Describe WHY it was memorable]

E.g. This experience was very memorable because it reminded me that life is short. It also taught me that I need to be more careful when riding my bicycle.
